DRESS CODE

GIRLS DRESS CODE

Shirts	Hunter or dark green, navy blue, or white polo style short or long sleeve dress shirts. Blue or white Oxford style shirts are allowed. All shirts must be collared & tucked in.
Pants/Shorts	Khaki or navy-blue Docker or uniform style pants or shorts. No rips or holes. Capris must be Docker or uniform style. Bottom of shorts must be within 4" of the knees.
Skorts/Skirt/ Jumpers	Khaki or navy-blue. shorts or leggings must be worn under skirts or dresses. Must be within 4" from the top of the knees. The official plaid skirt must be purchased from C&J or Lands' End. If ordering at C&J, tell them Evergreen Academy. Minimum length should be 4" from the top of the knees. If ordering from Lands' End, must order "White/Evergreen Plaid." (SEE PICTURE)
Sweaters	Solid color: navy-blue, dark or hunter green, or white only.
Sweatshirts	Quarter zips and sweatshirts featuring an approved EA logo (i.e., the crest or letters) are permitted during class over a collared uniform shirt. On Spirit Dress days, hoodies are acceptable, but must exclusively represent EA.
Leggings/Tights	Leggings/tights can be worn under skirts and must coordinate with the uniform and not draw undue attention.
Shoes/Socks	Tennis shoes, western boots, and dress shoes are allowed. No clogs, flip-flops, sandals, "crocs", house slippers, etc. Socks must coordinate with the school uniform and not draw undue attention.
Belts	K5 not required. 1st grade is encouraged but not required. 2nd grade and up are required to wear a belt with uniform pants and shorts. Must coordinate with clothing.
Hair	Reasonably maintained, groomed, and natural hair colors are required (i.e., no purple hair).
Jewelry	Earrings and studs allowed.
P.E.	School uniforms and tennis shoes only
Chapel Dress	Regular school dress code required.
Spirit Dress	Each Friday or on specifically designated days, students can wear blue jeans or uniform pants with an EA spirit t-shirt, sweatshirt, or hoodie. No rips or holes. T-shirts can be untucked. Belts are not required.
After School	Modest dress requirements. No midriff tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps, low cut shirts, or skintight shirts.

BOYS DRESS CODE

Shirts	Hunter or dark green, navy blue, or white polo style short or long sleeve dress shirts. Blue or white Oxford style shirts are allowed. All shirts must be collared & tucked in.
Pants/Shorts	Khaki or navy-blue Docker or uniform style pants or shorts. No rips or holes. Bottom of shorts must be within 4" of the knees.
Sweaters	Solid color: navy-blue, dark or hunter green, or white only.
Sweatshirts	Quarter zips and sweatshirts featuring an approved EA logo (i.e., the crest or letters) are permitted during class over a collared uniform shirt. On Spirit Dress days, hoodies are acceptable, but must exclusively represent EA.
Shoes/Socks	Tennis shoes, western boots, and dress shoes allowed. No clogs, flip-flops, sandals, "Crocs", house slippers, etc. Socks must coordinate with the school uniform and not draw undue attention.
Belts	K5 not required. 1 st grade is encouraged but not required. 2 nd grade and up are required to wear a belt with uniform pants and shorts. Must coordinate with clothing.
Hair	Reasonably maintained, groomed, and natural colors are required (i.e., no purple hair).
Jewelry	Earrings and studs are not allowed.
P.E.	School uniforms and tennis shoes only.
Chapel Dress	Regular school dress code required.
Spirit Dress	Each Friday or specially designated days, students can wear blue jeans or uniform pants with an EA spirit t-shirt, sweatshirt, or hoodie. No rips or holes. T-shirts can be untucked. Belts are not required.
After School	Must maintain modest dress requirements.
