We EDUCATE

Within the lower school classroom, students delve into Bible stories, grasp biblical principles, and explore the essence of following Christ. Integral to our curriculum, students engage in the practice of memorizing and reciting Scripture annually as part of their immersion in the study of the Bible.

We TRAIN

Each academic year, lower school teachers at EA set specific spiritual goals for their classes, aiming to foster a more personal mentorship with their students. This involves daily practices such as praying with and for their students, imparting lessons on friendship, and integrating Gospel teachings into disciplinary measures. Beyond the classroom, our students actively participate in service opportunities.
