BOYS DRESS CODE

TOPS

1. SHIRTS

- Collared short/long sleeve polos (Dark Green, Navy, White);
- Collared long sleeve Oxford (Blue or White)

2. SWEATERS

- Cardigan or pullover over collared shirts
- Solid Dark Green, Navy, or White

3. SWEATSHIRTS

- Quarter zips/sweatshirts over collared polo or Oxford shirts
- Hoodies on Spirit Dress Days only
- EA-approved logos/designs only

BOTTOMS

1. PANTS & SHORTS

- Docker/uniform style; Tan Khaki or Navy
- Traditional style **with a functioning button and zipper**
- Must fit appropriately; neat, clean, and free of holes, frays, or excessive fading
- **NOT PERMITTED:** elastic waistbands, drawstrings, cargo styles, joggers, leggings, denim-style pants
- No rips or holes; must be within 4" of the knee

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- **Footwear:** Athletic shoes, dress shoes, and boots permitted
- **Socks & Belts:** Socks must be solid white, dark, or gray; belts are not required
- **Shirts:** Must be tucked in except on Spirit Dress Days
- **Grooming:** Neat, natural color; not in eyes or past collar; no facial hair
- **Jewelry/Piercings:** No ear or body piercings
- **School Requirements:** P.E.—uniforms and tennis shoes only; Chapel—regular dress code required
- **Spirit Dress (Fridays):** Blue jeans, jean shorts, or uniform pants/shorts with EA spirit t-shirt, sweatshirt, or hoodie; no rips or holes. **JEAN SHORTS CANNOT BE FRAYED OR TIGHT FITTING**
- **After School:** Modest dress code applies



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GRIZZLY FREE DRESS FRIDAY

Free Dress Friday is a special privilege that allows students to express their personality while honoring God through modesty, respect, and good judgment. Participation is a privilege and may be suspended for individual students or canceled school-wide if expectations are not followed.

General Expectations

All clothing should be:

- Clean, modest, and appropriately fitting.
- Comfortable and safe for classroom and playground activities.
- Free of offensive, inappropriate, or distracting words, images, symbols, or messages.

Acceptable Attire

Students may wear:

- Jeans, khakis, joggers, and casual pants without rips or holes.
- Dresses, skirts, and shorts that are no shorter than **4 inches above the knee**.
- T-shirts, polos, blouses, sweaters, sweatshirts, and hoodies that meet school standards.
- Athletic shoes, boots, sandals with secure straps, or other safe footwear.

Unacceptable Attire

The following are not permitted:

- Clothing that is revealing, excessively tight, sheer, or exposes the midriff, shoulders, low necklines, or undergarments, including crop tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops, and off-the-shoulder tops.
- Shorts, skirts, or dresses shorter than **4 inches above the knee**, or leggings worn as pants unless covered by a skirt or dress of appropriate length.
- Clothing with rips, holes, or frayed areas that expose skin or undergarments.
- Pajamas, slippers, blankets, costumes, hats, or hoods (unless approved for a designated school event).
- Flip-flops, slides, or other footwear that presents a safety concern.
- Clothing or accessories displaying inappropriate language, crude humor, offensive messages, or references to violence, weapons, alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs, gambling, or immoral behavior.
- Clothing or images promoting values, entertainment, music, symbols, or lifestyles inconsistent with the biblical beliefs and mission of the school, including gothic, emo, occult, witchcraft, supernatural, horror, or death-themed imagery such as skulls, skeletons, bones, ghosts, grim reapers, or zombies.

Administrative Discretion

School administration reserves the right to determine whether attire is appropriate for the school environment. Students who do not meet these guidelines may be required to change into a school uniform or have a parent provide appropriate clothing.
